Project Description:

Pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 750-1.18 and 750-1.19, the Priority Ranking System known as New York State's Environmental Benefit Permit Strategy (EBPS), the Department has completed a full technical review, prepared a draft permit, and has made a tentative determination, subject to public comment or other information, to approve a renewal and modification of SPDES Permit #NY0028410. The facility discharges treated sanitary sewage to the Niagara River (Class/Standard: A-S/A-S) and combined sewer overflows to outfalls throughout the City of Buffalo. As a result of the EBPS full technical review, a new five year term is proposed.

DEC proposes to incorporate the following modifications into this permit: (1) updates to permit format, definitions and general conditions; (2) addition of "WWTP Special Conditions" for the operation of the WWTF; (3) addition of a schedule of compliance with interim effluent limits and schedule of additional submittals for several items; (4) updated WWTF flow diagram; (5) revisions to effluent limits, monitoring requirements, and reporting requirements for Outfall 002; and (6) revisions to effluent limits for Outfall 001/01A. The permit incorporates requirements contained within NYSDEC Consent Judgement R9-20060922-35.
